Who are we?

Based in Altrincham, the Hub is a busy community centre resourced by Altrincham Baptist Church, working in partnership with Trafford Council- we aim to be a welcoming space for everyone.

We have a wide range of classes, clubs and courses for all ages, alongside a professional counselling centre and debt counselling service. The Hub café sits at the heart of the centre.

Who are we looking for?

The Hub café opens Tuesday-Friday, and relies upon a strong team of volunteers to support the daily supervisor. We are looking for new café assistant volunteers- anyone with enthusiasm, keen to work with others as part of a team, share our values, and with an ability to keep their head when things get busy!

What's involved?

Responsibilities can include: start- of- day baking; welcoming customers; taking orders & operating the till; preparation of food & drinks; using the coffee machine, to the more behind the scenes cleaning & dishwashing.

Volunteers are welcome to be engaged with all or just some (if preferred) of the tasks above.

NB All volunteers must be willing to comply with our Health & Safety and Food Hygiene guidelines.

What's in it for you?

Become part of a friendly & committed team in a wonderful community environment. Meet new people across all age groups. Gain confidence in a work setting or develop a new skill. (All necessary training will be provided.)

Time Commitment

It is helpful if volunteers can make a regular commitment, however, we are nothing if not flexible!! Shifts can range from as little as a couple of hours to a full day or more a week. (Café staffing hours run 9am-4pm, Tuesday to Friday)
